# Center Against Rape and Domestic Violence

The Center Against Rape and Domestic Violence (CARDV) is a non-profit organization with 24 employees and over 200 volunteers in Linn and Benton Counties of Oregon. CARDV's mission is two fold: to provide services and support to those affected by sexual and domestic violence and to provide education and leadership within the community to change the societal conditions that cultivate these forms of violence.

All CARDV services are free, confidential, and for anyone who experiences sexual or domestic violence regardless of age, gender identity, sexuality, ability or immigration status. Services include a 24-hour

crisis and support line, crisis response, emergency shelter, legal advocacy, medical accompaniment, support groups, long-term case management and ongoing emotional support.

With the support of the community, annually over 7,500 survivors seeking support for sexual and domestic violence are able to access services.

To access CARDV services call [541] 754-0110 or [800] 927-0197. The crisis and support line is answered 24 hours-a-day, and for those in need of support, information, safety planning and other resources to survivors of domestic and sexual violence, as well as their supporters.

In 2017, the CPI Charitable Trust awarded \$14,282 in grants this year, thanks to CPI members and employees who give to the trust through our Operation Round Up program.

Since its launch in 1993, the trust has awarded \$339,569 in total grants to nonprofit organizations providing assistance throughout CPI's six county service territory.
