While in Washington D.C., youth tour participants will have the opportunity see their nation's capital up close, learn about the political process and interact with Oregon's political delegation. During this weeklong trip students will gain a personal understanding of American history and the role electrical cooperative have and continue to play in shaping rural America.

### **Who Can Enter?**

Any high school junior who attends public or private school and whose full-time residence receives electric service from Consumers Power is eligible to enter.

Immediate family members of any director or full-time employees of CPI are not eligible.
